6. The court took no action to remove the fire truck for sale from Gov Deals web site.




7. Commissioner's report consist of public meetings the commissioners would attend.

Action Items:


5. Discussion and action to approve 3 temporary Directors representing Coryell County on the Middle Trinity Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors. (Firth)
