

Routine Monitoring Violation Total Coli form Rule

Mountain Water Supply Corporation/PWS ID 0500020 failed to collect the required number of bacteriological samples for coli form monitoring of the water distribution system during June, 2011. This monitoring is required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's "Drinking Water Standards" and the federal "Safe Drinking Water Act," Public Law 95-523.

Bacteriological samples are used to monitor water quality and indicate if the water is free of coli form bacteria. Our water system is required to submit 2 bacteriological samples each month. Failure to collect all required bacteriological samples is a violation of the monitoring requirements and we are required to notify you of this violation.

"The samples were collected and passed by Waco Water Laboratory. The Water System Operator labeled the samples as special instead of routine and therefore they were not in compliance with TCEQ. Results from Waco Water Laboratory for this time period may be viewed at the Mountain Water Supply office.
