COURTROOM RULES

ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE COURTROOM SHALL BE CLEAN AND DRESSED IN A MANNER THAT REFLECTS DIGNITY AND RESPECT FOR THE COURT

THE DRESS CODE IS STRICTLY ENFORCED. IF YOU WEAR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE COURTROOM.

- Shorts
- Flip-flop style shoes
- T-shirts, muscle shirts
- Clothing with profane, vulgar language or pictures
- Short skirts or dresses
- Hat, caps or other headgear not required by religion
- Tube, halter, tank or crop tops
- Excessive jewelry, or facial piercing jewelry of any kind
- Shirts that are not tucked in
- Drooping/saggy pants
- Sunglasses not required by prescription

ALL CLOTHING MUST BE NEAT AND CLEAN.

**NO CHEWING GUM OR CHEWING TOBACCO.
NO FOOD OR DRINK.**

NO CHILDREN WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE COURTROOM. PLEASE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS PRIOR TO THE HEARING.

YOU MUST ARRIVE 15 MINUTES BEFORE YOUR HEARING TIME TO ENSURE YOUR PRESENCE IN THE COURTROOM.

TALKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE COURTROOM WHILE THE JUDGE IS ON THE BENCH.

OFFENSIVE, VULGAR, RACIST, SEXIST OR OBSCENE LANGUAGE IS PROHIBITED.

FOR SAFETY PURPOSES, ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES (including cell phone, pagers, iPods, and cameras) ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE COURTROOM. Please leave these devices at home or secure them in your vehicle.
