WAIVER OF RIGHTS

NOW COMES the above named Defendant in the above entitled and numbered cause and makes the following voluntary statements:

1. That I am sane and understand the nature of the charges contained in the complaint and information in this cause.
2. That I understand that I have the right to a formal arraignment.
3. That I understand that I have the right to a trial by jury, whether I plead "Not Guilty", "Guilty", or "Nolo Contendere".
4. That I have the right to be confronted with witnesses against me, whether I have a trial by jury or a trial before the

Court.

5. That I have the right to be represented by an attorney and to have an attorney appointed to represent me if I cannot afford one. That the Court has warned and admonished me as to the consequences of waiving counsel and of the dangers and disadvantages of self representation.

6. That I have the right to have all proceedings/hearings recorded and that a written record be made of the proceedings/hearings.

7. That I have the right to have a Pre-Sentence Investigation done prior to entering a plea to the offense with which I am charged and prior to the Court imposing sentence.

8. That I have been advised by the Court of the consequences of my plea, including the minimum and maximum punishment provided by law.

9. That I have the right to appeal, the right to file a Motion for New Trial and the right to expunction of the record in certain circumstances.

HOWEVER, I DESIRE TO WAIVE AND DO WAIVE THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS:

1. I waive arraignment and the reading of the information.

2. I waive the right to a trial by jury and request the consent of the State of Texas and the Honorable Court.

3. I waive the right to be confronted with the witnesses against me.

4. I waive the right to be represented by an attorney and to have an attorney appointed to represent me if I cannot afford one.

5. I waive the right to have the proceedings/hearings recorded and I waive a written record of the proceedings/hearings.

6. I hereby request in writing that a Pre-Sentence Investigation not be done in my case and that the Court does not order such an investigation.

7. I hereby waive my right to an appeal, right to a new trial and right to file for an expunction of this offense in certain circumstances.

I further enter this my PLEA OF _____ to the offense of _____ and pray the Court to proceed immediately, on the filing hereof, to accept my plea, waiver of trial by jury, waiver of counsel, right to appeal, new trial and expunction and to enter judgment thereon.

It appearing to the Court that the Defendant is sane and understands the nature of the charges against him/her, and the attorney for the State and the Defendant consent and approve the waiver of a trial by jury and waiver of counsel, and the Defendant is uninfluenced by any persuasion or delusive hope of pardon or probation prompting him to confess his/her guilt, the Court therefore finds the Defendant's PLEA OF GUILTY and the waivers contained herein, including the waiver of counsel, to be knowingly, intelligently, freely and voluntarily made and the Court accepts the Defendant's plea and approves the waivers herein contained.
