CORYELL COUNTY SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR COURT APPOINTED ATTONEYS FOR JUVENILE MATTERS

Attorneys appointed to represent a juvenile in proceedings in which an adjudication of delinquent conduct, determinate sentencing, or transfer to a felony court after approval of petition by the Grand Jury shall be paid in accordance with the provisions herein for the payment of attorneys appointed in non-capital felony cases.

Attorneys appointed to represent a juvenile alleged to be a child in need of supervision or in all other juvenile matters not described in the preceding paragraph shall be paid in accordance with the provisions herein for the payment of attorneys appointed in misdemeanor cases.

EXPERTS HOURLY RATES:

As billed and approved by the Court, not to exceed \$100.00 per hour without prior approval of the Court

EXPENSES OF INVESTIGATION:

At amount incurred, as approved by the Court (Other than Investigator)
Investigators and experts to submit such documentation as Court requires.

Minimum Rate per Hour	\$50.00
Maximum Rate per Hour	\$150.00

DEAF INTERPRETORS

PROCEDURE

1. Counsel shall keep an accurate account of his/her time spent, subject matter of the time expenditure, dates involved, necessity for expenditure of time, and be prepared to furnish reasonable documentation thereof if requested by the Court.

2. Counsel shall petition the Court in which the case is pending prior to incurring expenses relating to investigation and expert testimony. Said petition shall state why these expenses are needed, how much they are expected to cost and any other information material to the request. The petition shall include an order granting or denying the request with a space for the amount of expense authorized if granted. The form of said petition is within counsel's discretion.

3. If prior approval is granted and expenses for investigation and expert testimony are incurred and payable, then a pay application must be submitted, and be accompanied by an invoice, statement or other supporting documentation from the provider of the services.
