5. Consent Agenda:

The consent agenda which consist of the County Clerk's report of all fees and fines collected in December 2018 was accepted after a motion by Commissioner Daren Moore and a second by Commissioner Don Jones.

The Minutes of the January 14, 2019 meeting of the Commissioner's Court were removed from the Consent Agenda after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Ray Ashby. The court voted to approve the minutes with a correction of the date after a motion by Commissioner Ray Ashby and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews.

Action Items:

6. Justin Latham, County Road and Bridge Administrator reported on progress in his department. A motion was made by Commissioner Daren Moore to add the report to the minutes of the Court, Commissioner Don Jones gave the motion a second and the court voted in favor. 7. The court voted to authorize the Road and Bridge Department to post a Notice to Bid request for hauling after a motion by Commissioner Daren Moore and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby. (Attached)

8. The court voted to authorize the County Attorney and the Road and Bridge Administrative to enter into an agreement for acquisition of additional right of way on Duncan road after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Don Jones.

9. The Sheriff's Office reported to the court that office had received a 2004 Ford Ranger and 2017 HMMWV Ambulance under the Government 1033 program. Commissioner Kyle Matthews moved to accept the donation and Commissioner Ray Ashby seconded. (Numbers Attached)

10. The court voted to move Pre-Trial Services Supervision from the County Judge to the Board of Trial Judges after a motion by Commissioner Daren Moore and a second to Commissioner Kyle Matthews.


11. The court voted to pay bills submitted for payment after a motion by Commissioner Don Jones and a second by Commissioner Kyle Matthews. (Attached)
